- Five to seven days of personal clothing

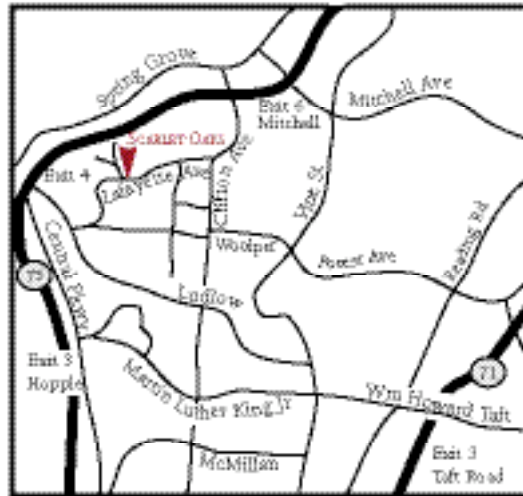
Although you can speak with our admissions director prior to admission you will need to expect:
